### Slap Cheek

There has been a case of slap cheek in Kindergarten and we wanted to alert you to the symptoms and signs to look out for in your child.

*A viral infection where there may be fever and redness of cheeks followed by a lacy rash on the body and limbs. This may recur for 1-3 weeks on exposure to stimuli e.g. light and heat. Incubation period, 4-20 days, period of communicability usually for 1 week before the onset of the rash. This could have implications in early pregnancy so please see your doctor if you are worried.*
